



Idaho Guided Hunts

Elk Hunts

The Gem State is home to some of the most beautiful Elk country in the west. Hunts take place in the rugged Bitterroot Mountains of northern Idaho's Lolo National Forest. These are true backcountry Elk hunts. In most cases mules are used to access hunting areas and hunting is then done on foot. Whether you choose to hunt screaming bulls in the rut or pursue them in the late season snow, you're in for some excitement. Archery and Rifle hunts are both available.

Mountain Lion Hunts

If you're after a trophy Mountain Lion, look no further than northern Idaho! In most cases these hunts are conducted from the outfitter's secure back-country base camp lodge. Lions will be pursued with hounds and hunters will give chase on snow machines and on foot. Lion hunts are extremely physical and hunters are urged to arrive in camp in the best physical condition possible. Archery and rifle hunters are both welcome on Lion hunts.

Bear Hunts

Black bear hunts are conducted at the highest elevations in the region and excellent bear hunting is available well into the month of June. Hunters will utilize tree stands and ground blinds overlooking well-established bait sites set up for trophy bears. More than half of the bears taken in this area are color-phase animals. Fall bear hunts are also available and can be combined with elk hunts for a truly unique trophy experience. Trophy Bear hunts using well trained hounds are also available.

Deposits and Payments

For Elk hunts a \$1,000 deposit required to book your hunt, \$1,000 second deposit due by May 1st. Balance due 30-days prior to hunt.

For Bear hunts a \$500 deposit is required to book your hunt. \$500 second deposit due by March 1st. Balance due 30-days prior to hunt.

For Lion hunts a \$1,000 deposit is required to book your hunt. \$1,000 second deposit due by July 1st. Balance due 30-days prior to hunt.

For Wolf hunts a \$1,000 deposit is required to book your hunt. \$1,000 second deposit due by July 1st. Balance due 30-days prior to hunt.

- All meals, lodging and guide service once you reach camp
- Meat/hides packed out and transported to taxidermist/processor
- Pick-up and drop-off in Missoula, MT
