



Kansas Semi-guided Hunts

Archery Whitetail Deer Hunts

Kansas offers some of the finest Whitetail Deer hunting west of the Mississippi. These semi-guided hunts take place on private land with trophy bucks most effectively hunted from elevated stands. Kansas Deer tags are obtained by random drawing with excellent draw odds. Applications are due by March 31 and the draw is conducted between mid-June and mid-July. Unsuccessful applicants are refunded any deposits.

Turkey Hunts

Turkey hunts take place in the Flint Hills of Kansas and offer a unique opportunity for the Turkey hunting enthusiast with the chance to harvest one of three species, The Rio, Eastern's and Hybrids. It is not uncommon to see more than one species during your days afield. Each 3-day hunt includes the opportunity to harvest two Turkey's.
