



New Mexico Guided Hunts

Elk Hunts

The Land of Enchantment is home to some of the biggest bulls in the western United States and is a must for any serious Elk hunter. Hunts take place in the well-known Gila National Forest in Southwest New Mexico. Hunts in other parts of New Mexico (with better draw odds) are also available.

Mule Deer Hunts

New Mexico is home to quality Mule Deer herds and the state produces some exceptional trophies each year. The majority of these trophy Mule Deer hunts take place in northern New Mexico, near the Colorado border. The most effective way to hunt these mature bucks is by spot-and-stalk methods.

Antelope Hunts

The skittish "Speed Goat" will provide a challenge for even the most seasoned big game hunter. Pursued on the prairies of New Mexico, you will have the opportunity to hone your spot-and-stalk, decoying and ground blind skills. Antelope hunts take place early in the season and can be a great, economical tune-up for your late season hunts.

Oryx Hunts

Oryx (or Gemsbok) are an Antelope species native to Africa which were introduced in New Mexico during the 1960's. Populations have expanded dramatically since their introduction on the old missile ranges where they are hunted today. The terrain on the missile ranges consists of gently rolling, highly accessible hills and open flats. This is truly a once-in-a-lifetime hunt as those who are lucky enough to draw a tag are not eligible to apply ever again.

Barbary Sheep

this non-native sheep now inhabits a large portion of New Mexico. Sheep are pursued primarily in southeastern New Mexico on both public and private land. The outfitters knowledge of this animals habits and preferred range have allowed them to enjoy high success rates on mature rams.
