New Mexico Guided Hunts - Landowner Tags

Mule Deer Hunts

Mule Deer hunts are conducted on as many as seven different ranches through out New Mexico however, the main ranch consists of 32,000 acres of prime Mule Deer hunting and habitat. The mule deer harvest success rate on this ranch has been 60-70% on deer ranging from 140-160 B&C. Harvest is limited each year in order to maintain the quality of the game on this ranch. This ranch is also home to deer that will push the 180" B&C mark.

Antelope Hunts

The skittish "Speed Goat" will provide a challenge for even the most seasoned big game hunter. These private land hunts offer exceptional harvest rates on trophy goats without the pressure of public land hunting.

Oryx Hunts

Introduced between 1969 and 1977 to the White Sands Missile Range in New Mexico, the Oryx (or Gemsbok) is an African antelope from the Kalahari Desert with both males and females having horns. The male's horns growing a bit thicker, and the female's growing a bit longer. This is truly a once-in-a-lifetime hunt as you have to draw a tag to hunt the White Sands Missile Range and can do so only once in your lifetime.
